

**Call for Submissions:  
2BB Quarterly**

**2BB (To Be Bad)** originated in the Anarchist Feminist caucus (AnFem) of the Metropolitan Anarchist Coordinating Council (MACC). After many discussions about the limitations of anarchism and statist forms of feminism, there was an expressed need for a specifically anarchist feminist space for women and femmes in the organizing community. This needed its own platform, so 2BB was formed.

We destroy domination in all of its forms. The boss exploits, the state subjugates, and patriarchy objectifies. This multi-headed enemy seeks to render us powerless. Liberation will only come when we no longer accept power over us and confront it fiercely.

We build interconnected relationships based on mutual respect and care. The individual is related to others, and part of a larger community. The work of care must be shared, just as other work, to have mutual aid.

We encourage a culture of consent and sex positivity. We condemn rape and all forms of abuse. We take control over our own bodies' wants and needs, and take pleasure in sexual experiences.

We create intersectional community that encourages equity over equality. People of color, trans, and gender nonconforming folks have unique experiences under capitalism, the state, and patriarchy. We center and amplify these experiences.

To be bad is to be a subject of our own struggle. We are not represented. We have our own voice, and determine our own course of action. We invite all femme, trans, and gender nonconforming individuals and collectives to join us. If you are masc identifying but are still interested in the challenge of feminist ideas, we also welcome you to participate. Submission guidelines/requirements listed below. Once published, copies will be available both in digital and hardcopy form.
