Masked to be seen, stand for all oppressed
"the ones who cover their faces so that their brothers and sisters in other lands can see"

Rhetoric priorities

joy as a necessity of life and activism

"Our own laws made books, medicine, laughter, sweets, and toys flourish"
"not having lost the capacity for being astounded, amazed"

Being forgotten worse than dying

"against forgetfulness" (86) "for having memory" (87)
"against oblivion"

Prefiguration

"and, so that they would understand what we wanted, we began to create in our own lands what we wanted."
(p 21)

Constant change

"all final options are a trap.

It's imperative to find the bear-brown horse" (93)

"when we are struggling to change things, we often forget changing ourselves"

Language

redefinition of what (110)

we take for granted

"civilization" (154)

Violence

"military intelligence" (this is frankly a contradiction, because those of us who are in the military are not intelligent)"

"we [as an army] could be ultimately disappeared"
